F. Zlatibor's note

Dear brothers and sisters, children and youth,

Christ is Risen!

The Great Lent is behind us, we welcomed the Holy Pascha with happiness and joy, we have put aside all our cares and obligations to rejoice and ponder about our resurrection. And we will do so year after year, generation after generation, other Feasts of the Holy Resurrection will come and pass, and we will be filled with joy anew and celebrate, but also grow old and when the time comes we will repose and we will rest awaiting with hope.

And that moment will come when time will stop, the trumpet will sound and we will all be resurrected, and the Lord God will appear in His Glory and will Judge us.

The Lord dressed in the Emperors Vestments, the Lord seated on the Throne of Light, the Lord with the Apostles and the Saints, the Lord in the Glory that was before the world was created, the Lord Whom history will not know or recognize, the Lord Whom we will know and recognize by His Glory as made known from icons, visions and providence.

The Lord will make a small but great sign:

We will recognize this sign and we will immediately understand who will go to the right and who will go to the left side. He will tell us: I was hungry – you fed me. I was thirsty – and you gave me drink. And I was sick and in prison, and you came to me. I was in need, and you gave me what I needed. Not only to me, but whatever you did for one of the least of my brethren, the needy – you did it for me.

And those who were condemned, or already knew that they belong to the left side: they will be told, you did no good to anyone. Depart from me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry, and you left me hungry, and I was thirsty and was left thirsty, I was a stranger and you did not take me in, and you know already the rest. The Judgement cannot be anything else but per each one's measure, so by justice who has done good deserves a reward, and who has not done good deserves punishment.



Yet brothers and sisters, before the Lord God is our intercessor the Most Holy Mother of God, the Holy Theotokos who will continue to pray to God for all of us.

Dear brothers and sisters, why did I write this for you on this Paschal day of Christ our Savior and our Resurrected God – precisely because by our faith, through our deeds, through our lives, gathered in our parish, we tirelessly continue with all that life signifies. We believe and we await the resurrection. Everything unfolded the way as we know until the day of Ascension when Christ returned to the Father from where he came to us.

But He did not ascend before He gathered all the disciples on a hill and blessed them, and gave them the last commands, and said to them, "lo, I <u>am</u> with you always, even unto the end of the world." And note, He did not say, "I <u>will be</u> with you until the end of the world." He is our Lord, yesterday, today and until the ages of the ages. Amen.

Report for the Archangel Gabriel Parish Newsletter May 2019

Work on preparation of detailed drawings and other documents, in regards to the treatment and drainage of storm water for the new church (and its parking lot) is in process. As explained in the last report conceptual approach to this solution was approved by the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) and City planners. Work on adjustments of the Landscape, Exterior Illumination and the Architectural Plans, with a new stormwater management has also already commenced.

Members of the Project team are putting an effort to have all the necessary material for Site Plan Approval ready during the month of May 2019.
