


## Στὸν Πόντιο Πιλάτο

Μετὰ τὴν ἀνάκριση ἀπὸ τὸ Συνέδριο, ὁ Χριστὸς ὁ δηγήθηκε στὸν Ρωμαῖο ἡγεμόνα, Πόντιο Πιλάτο. Αὐτὸς τὸν θεώρησε ἀθῶο καὶ ἥθελε νὰ τὸν ἀφῆσῃ ἐλεύθερο. Ὁ λαὸς ὅμως, ὑποκινούμενος ἀπὸ τὸ Συνέδριο, ζήτησε νὰ καταδικαστῇ. Τότε ὁ Πιλάτος ἔνιψε συμβολικὰ τὰ χέρια του, λέγοντας ὅτι δὲν ἔφερε εὐθύνη γιὰ τὸν Σταυρικὸ θάνατο τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Ματθαῖος κζ' 11-25.



### Before Pilate

After being interrogated by the high priests, Christ was led to the Governor, Pontius Pilate. Pilate found no guilt in Him and wanted to release Him. The crowd protested and wanted to sentence Christ to death. Pilate then symbolically washed his hands, saying that he was no longer responsible for Christ's coming Crucifixion. Matthew 27:11-25.
