


In Jesus Christ the real meaning and purpose of the Passover and Exodus are revealed and accomplished!



God, through Moses, ordered the Israelites to select lambs, to slay them and place some blood on the two doorposts and the lintel of their houses.

At midnight the Lord slew the Egyptian firstborn. The houses marked with blood were spared when the Lord passed over, saving the Isrealites from slavery to the Pharaoh and allowing them to escape to the Promissed Land.

Out of His infinite love for us, Christ died on the cross so that we could be saved. Jesus Christ is Himself the New Passover. He is the Passover Lamb, which is slain for the deliverance of all people from the powers of evil.

The real "pharaoh" is the devil who holds people in slavery. The real saviour is Jesus who leads the people from the slavery to sin and death into the "promised land" of the Kingdom of God.
